Expected Outcome: NCQA PCMH Recognition

Expected Timeframe: 18–24 months

Recommended Cohort Participants:

- Physician lead
- Practice manager or administrative lead
- Other clinical lead (LPN, MA, care coordinator, etc.)

Cohort Participation Schedule:

- Monthly conference calls/webinars
- Quarterly interactive work sessions (in-person)
- Periodic status reporting and gap analyses
- Individual consultations as needed





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
